Background on Sgt Andres Burgos

Military Service:

Andres Burgos, a 29 year old Marine veteran, served for 8 years as a Security Forces Guard, Infantryman, and Recruiter. He was in charge of 42 Marines during operations in Haiti and as a Marine Corps Recruiter, helped 72 young Americans enlist into the Corps. Andres was honorably discharged from the Marine Corps in 2007. His personal awards include; Navy Marine Corps Achievement Medal, a Good Conduct Medal, a Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, a National Defense Medal, a Sea Service Deployment Ribbon, Navy Unit Citation, and a Meritorious Unit Citation.

Why he needs our assistance:

On June 29, 2011, Sergeant Burgos was involved in a serious motorcycle accident. He was treated at UMass Medical Center in Worcester. His right leg and one finger were amputated. Sgt. Burgos will require additional surgery in the coming months. He has plenty of ties to the local community and the region.
